

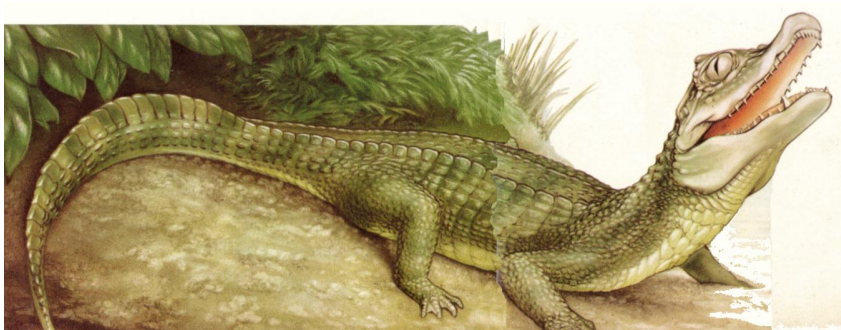
The Life Cycle of a Crocodile: (Animals and Living Things)



Stage 1 (0-3months)

Egg: sits in a nest on dry land protected by the mother who sits close by.

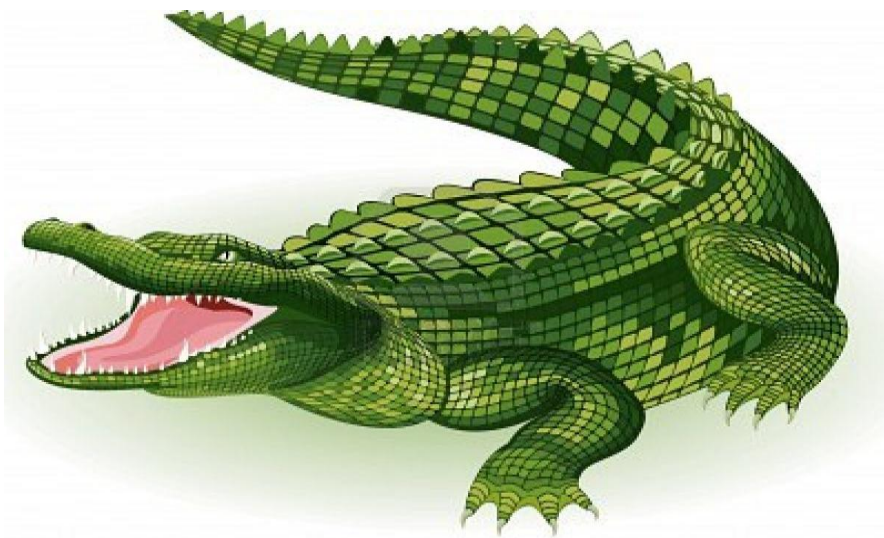
Hatchling: an animal that has just hatched from an egg.



Stage 2-Crocodile Youth

(2-8 years)

Crocodiles grow and learn to hunt on their own.



Stage 3-Adult Crocodile

Crocodiles become an adult between 8-10 years old. An adult male is a huge creature and measures 6m long. It is one of the largest reptiles in the world. They are fierce predators.

Reptile: A group of scaly-skinned, cold blooded animals that includes lizards, snakes, tortoises, turtles, crocodiles and aligators. Most reptiles lay eggs and always on dry land.

Predator: An animal that hunts other animals
